



Aboriginal child health immersion program for Aboriginal student doctors

Aboriginal student doctors from all three medical schools in WA are invited to apply for a funded, extra-curricular week of face-to-face learning in Aboriginal child health at the Child and Adolescent Health Service (CAHS), based out of Perth Children's Hospital (PCH) on the QEII Medical Campus.

Participants will be given an interesting and dynamic introduction to Aboriginal child health with clinical placements, tutorials, mentoring, reflective supervision and student networking opportunities over five days.

The annual program offers

- The chance to meet senior staff from CAHS Aboriginal Health, Koorliny Moort and other PCH departments
- Student bursaries of up to \$500 non-clinical students and \$1000 for clinical students
- Opportunity to introduce, consolidate or extend specific learning in Aboriginal child health
- To create interest and opportunities for ongoing association with CAHS

Who can apply

Pre-clinical and clinical year Aboriginal student doctors from all three WA medical schools in any year group are invited to apply for one of 12 places.

New and returning students are eligible.
